The congress venue is University College Dublin (UCD) Ireland's largest and most diverse university with over 30,000 students from over 124 countries. The congress will be accommodated in the O'Brien Science Centre, O'Reilly Hall and Newman Buildings. The main UCD campus at Belfield is located on a 132 hectare site, 4km south of Dublin city centre.

- **Submission Types and the Review Process**

English is the official language for all congress communications. You can choose from the following submission formats, Scientific Symposia, Practitioner Forum, Scientist-Practitioner Collaborative Forum, Individual Paper, Poster, Panel Discussion or Debate. All abstracts are submitted via the conference website. You will find more information on abstract submission [here](#). The program committee will send each submission to international blind reviewers who have expertise in the area related to your abstract. There are separate reviewers for scientific and practitioner submissions. The first author of an abstract is considered to be the presenter of the paper or the chair of the symposium or forum at the congress.

- **Submission Deadline and Dates**

The submission deadline is September 27th, 2016, Midnight GMT. All contributions are due on this day. Applicants will receive notification of acceptance no later than January, 2017.
